


Stage, Differentiation, & Grade

These are easily confused, but are actually very different metrics that say very different things about a tumor


Stage | Tells *how far* cancer has travelled from the site of the original tumor




Stage 1Tumor is small and hasn't spread



Stage 2Tumor is large but hasn't spread




Stage 3Tumors have spread to neighboring lymph nodes



Stage 4Tumors have spread to other organs


Differentiation |

Tells **how abnormal** the tumor cells look when compared to the surrounding healthy cells



Well-differentiated Cancer Cell:


has a shape and structure that resembles nearby healthy cells



Poorly-differentiated Cancer Cell:

has a completely different shape and structure

Grade | Tells *how quickly* the tumor cells are dividing
